Brasil de 20 Copas-Claudio Nogueira 2018-05-22 De quatro em quatro anos, o Brasil para. E é como se os corações dos mais de 210 milhões de brasileiros se transformassem e passassem a ter os contornos de uma esfera, isto é, de uma bola de futebol. Normalmente em junho, como neste ano, e a cada quadriênio, é tempo de Copa do Mundo. E para o país que é o maior detentor de títulos mundiais, uma Copa é muito mais do que simplesmente uma competição de futebol. É uma missão, uma questão de honra, de orgulho nacional, e a melhor oportunidade de o país mostrar ao mundo o que melhor conseguiu produzir em seus 518 anos desde o Descobrimento: seu futebol. Com base nisso, o jornalista esportivo e escritor Claudio Nogueira está concretizando seu mais novo projeto: "Brasil de 20 Copas" , uma obra de consulta que inclui todas as partidas, escalões, gols e locais das participações da única seleção a ter estado em todos os Mundiais de Futebol de 1930 a 2014, aquela que veste a camisa amarela canarinho. "O objetivo desta obra é a de trazer novamente à memória os cinco títulos mundiais da Seleção, representados por cinco estrelas na camisa, mas também as edições do torneio em que brilharam estrelas de outras cores que não a verde e a amarela. Aqui estão todos os jogos do Brasil em todas as Copas, bem como todas as finais, artilheiros e outras surpresas", enfatiza Claudio Nogueira. "Acredito que assim, resumidamente, o leitor terá um panorama completo das 20 Copas. É, acima de tudo, uma maneira de fazer memória e exaltar a tantos jogadores que, campeões ou não, representaram nosso país em uma Copa do Mundo". Na primeira parte, o autor enfoca as Cinco Estrelas, isto é, as campanhas das edições vencidas pelos brasileiros. Ali, os leitores poderão conferir jogo a jogo, todos os resultados das trajetórias vitoriosas. Na segunda, denominada Outras Estrelas, o pesquisador inclui as súmulas de todos os confrontos brasileiros e as finais em que outras seleções foram campeãs. Neste ano, de 14 de junho a 15 de julho, os olhos do mundo estarão voltados para a Rússia, sede do 21o Mundial. Será a primeira vez que aquele país irá organizar o torneio, e também a primeira Copa num país do Leste Europeu, além da décima edição disputada na Europa. O Mundial terá partidas em 12 estádios de 11 cidades: Moscou (a capital, que terá dois arenas), Ekaterinburgo, Kaliningrado, Kazan, Nijni Novgorod, Rostov, São Petersburgo, Samara, Saransk, Sochi e Volgogrado.

Sports Mega-Events and Urban Legacies-Eduardo Alberto Cusce Nobre 2016-11-23 This book examines the urban legacy of the 2014 football World Cup in Brazil across the seven cities that hosted matches. The authors, all experts and natives of South America, analyse the context and impacts of hosting the World Cup for each of the host cities.
